I have to extend my heart felt "THANK YOU" to each and every club member who showed up and participated in these two events. We could not have done it without you! That is what makes this Guild great.



Bob then provided a demonstration of a long-stemmed goblet. The demo started at 7:35 and finished at 8:05.


Show and tell was well attended and numerous items were displayed.










BOWL MAPLE






