Meanwhile holding a raffle each day with fantastic items made by our members. We broke down on Sunday the 18<sup>th</sup> and took our lathes right out to the St. Lucie Fairgrounds.

We finished setting up for the St. Lucie County Fair on Thursday the 23<sup>rd</sup>. The Fair opened on Friday and ran through Sunday March 5<sup>th</sup>. 


