## **May 2023**

At our April meeting we discussed our participation at the Stuart Waterfest. There were a couple of sales and a goodly number of tops made. We did not have a raffle for this one and if we do it again next year, we will have a raffle. The setup was good as we had a covered area next to our canopy that we used for display.

Our treasurer Steve Lasher is in the process of updating the roster and reported that we had more than \$5,000.00 in our account. A discussion was held about the purchase of new lathes, and it was decided that we would purchase two new |ET 12 x 21 lathes. They have been ordered.

The club sold the 14" reaves drive JET lathe that was donated to the club for \$1,100.00 and the antique Treadle lathe that was being stored at Heathcote was sold for \$400.00. That money will go toward the new lathes.

The Board, after a review of the Club's By-Laws, recommend that the club elect a second Vice president who "shall be the Chairperson of the Programs Committee". As such the 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice president shall be responsible for scheduling programs for general meetings and such other events as decided by the Board of Directors. Ron Augustyne was nominated for the position and elected by a vote of the members present.

The members passed a motion that we purchase an audio unit for use by the president and demonstrators. We announced that we plan to hold a "Beginners Class" In June limited to six people who signed up.

The Demo of how to make duplicates was done by Jack. We had "show and Tell" and adjournment.

On Saturday April 22<sup>nd</sup>, we had a demo by Bob Ashley of how to make a sphere two ways. We then had a Q & A with the members present on various turning subjects
