TWTC General Meeting Minutes February 8, 2024

Meeting Minutes Treasure Coast Woodturner Guild

8 February 2024

Meeting started at 7:00 with a Pledge of Allegiance.

Recognition of visitors - Carl Myers

Bob Ashley made a motion to accept the minutes of the January meeting as recorded in the February Newsletter. It was seconded by Jimmy Porter and the motion was passed.

Steve Lasher presented the Treasurer's report: Current balance of funds is \$3,213. The Hartford insurance policy has been paid for 2024. Upcoming expenditures include \$200 for AAW insurance and \$50 rent to IRSC for use of facilities since January 2023. The rent is a monthly payment, not a per-day charge. Steve continues to collect dues from members for 2024.

Jimmy Porter, as the Safety Officer reviewed some safe practices in spindle turning. It included properly tightening the chuck, securing work with the tailstock, Keeping tools sharp, using the tool rest properly and maintaining situational awareness.

Old Business

Bob Ashley announced that the annual calendar of events and the subjects for demonstrations would be finalized by the March meeting.

New Business

Bob noted that there will be a hands-on session at IRSC on 17 February. Ron Augustyne will open the classroom that day. He asked for volunteer instructors to contact him. Fred then asked if the Hartford insurance covered non-AAW instructors liability. Bob Haarer responded that all instructors were covered regardless of AAW membership.

Bob then announced that the St. Lucie County Fair would be taking place 23 Feb – 3 March. Monday through Friday 9am to 4pm. All personnel wishing to participate need to go to the office on the fairgrounds to get identification cards and parking passes before the Fair opens. Bob announced that he wanted participants to indicate the times when they would attend using sign-up sheets that he would circulate later in the meeting. The set-up will be on the 22nd, starting 9am at the IRSC to pack up the lathes and equipment.

Demonstration

Bob Ashley conducted a demonstration from 7:35 to 8:15 showing how to turn tops for the fair.

A discussion arose regarding the ownership of texturing tools used in the past and the notion that the club might purchase two brands of texturing tools. This resulted in a motion by Steve, seconded by Fred. The motion was approved by voice vote.

A second discussion regarding printing business cards for the club. The discussion included acknowledgement that club membership applications are available at club events and that those sheets have more information than a business card and have the application, should someone want to join the club. This subject was tabled for later examination.

Steve stepped forward to encourage members to participate in the St Lucie County Fair to increase club exposure and to show support for the club.

Bob then laid the sign-up sheets for members to fill out. Members then dispersed and one member distributed pecan wood he had brought down from up north.

Attendance at this meeting was 19.




