



8 August 2024

Meeting started at 7:00 with a Pledge of Allegiance led by Bob Ashley

Bob then asked members to silence their phones and asked for volunteers to learn how to use the club video equipment. No members volunteered. There were no new visitors recognized.

Bob asked if there was a motion to accept the July minutes. There was a motion, seconded and it was passed.

The Treasurer reported in an e-mail that the club has a balance of \$3,284.87.

Old Business:

Bob announced that the orders for club shirts had been turned-in that day and that they should be ready for distribution at the September meeting.

The Basic Skills Classes had been completed with positive feedback from the 4 students. The Board will discuss holding additional classes for more advanced skills.

The club lunch with family members was a great success with plenty of excellent food. The Board will consider holding a similar event when snowbirds are in town.

Bob then said that it was his recollection that there was not 100% consensus at the July meeting regarding the Hands-on session, so he announced that the club would keep the Hands-on Saturday meeting the second Saturday after the monthly General Meeting. This is in direct contradiction to the July meeting minutes that recorded the majority vote of the membership to hold the Hands-on meeting on the Saturday immediately after the General Meeting.

AS a follow up to last month's discussion about the president not being available to lead a club function. Bob said he was going to draft a letter for approval by the AAW that once approved would be presented to the board and general membership with the intention of changing the clubs By-Laws. Jack then performed the demonstration with a brief video showing the basic concept.


