OLD BUSINESS

Bob Ashley announced that the future General Meetings and Hands-On Meetings will be combined and held on the second Saturday of the month. This was discussed at the October General Meeting and was passed unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS

Bob Ashley asked for nominations for club officers for an election in December. He polled the current officers regarding their willingness to continue in office. Only one officer indicated his desire to step down. The nomination for 1st Vice President was Julie who is willing to fill that role.

Conrad asked if the club could add an additional Board position for the immediate past President. After considerable discussion a motion was made to add a seat to the Board for the past President, seconded and passed 7 to 6 in favor.

A question was raised regarding holding additional weekend meetings for classes or other special meetings and if that would result in any additional payments to IRSC. Bob Haarer confirmed that our payment is fixed at \$50/ month and we can schedule as many weekend meetings as we desire.

Bob Ashley then announced that the Heathcote Garden of Lights schedule has the club participating on the following dates: November 29 & 30, December 6, 7, 13, 14, 20, 21, 27, 28, January 3 & 4. The events start at 5:30 and close at 9:00. The club will move equipment to Heathcote the morning of November 29. At the close of each date, equipment may be stored in the Pioneer House. Each day of the event, the equipment will be removed from storage and set-up prior to 5:30. He said that he hoped that there would be a robust participation of the club members. He asked that members sign up on the forms he had prepared. All members are encouraged to bring work to sell and advance turning of tops was welcome.

Bob reminded the club that the Florida Woodturning Symposium will be on February 14 - 162025, and will be held at the RP Funding Center in Lakeland, Florida.
